BBDL Covid-19 Rules & Regulations

BBDL will be following the regulations set out by the Federal, Provincial, or Regional Governments. For specific rules, see below:

- 1. All players must be double vaccinated to enter the Bars/Restaurants.
- 2. All players must sign in.
- 3. All players must wear a mask. Face coverings are no longer permitted (i.e. Scarves, Bandanas, Neck Gaiters/Warmers, etc.) More on this below.
 - 4. All players must maintain social distancing of 2 meters (6ft)
 - 5. All players must follow Health Canada Covid Regulations.

BBDL Covid-19 Rules as it relates to Players:

- 1. All players must wear a mask. Specifically, when you are not in your seat. Example, if you are waiting to shoot, are shooting, going to the bar, or bathroom, etc., masks must always be worn.
- 2. All players must maintain social distancing of 2 meters (6ft), if possible. If this is not possible, masks must be worn.
- 3. All players are not to handle other people's darts, drinks, or chalkers. Players are not to have physical contact with others. This includes, but is not limited to, hand shaking, fist pumping at the beginning or ending of games. Verbal acknowledgements shall be used.
- 4. All players are to follow the Federal, Provincial, and Regional laws mandated for bars/restaurants. If a bartender, or owner of the bar must consistently remind players to follow the rules, they have the right to ask you to leave regardless if you are in a middle of a game or not.
- 5. If a Captain's home bar is not in compliance with the mandates, that Captain will be given the option to play at a later date or forfeit their match. The Captain will be responsible for working with their bar prior to next dart night to come to a resolution. If no resolution can be made, either the Captain can move their team to a different bar, or not play. No refund will be given once games have been played.
- 6. Any players or teams who feel unsafe while playing due to other players or teams not complying with the Federal, Provincial, or Regional laws set out, have every right to leave the premises without being penalized. In the event that a team walks out, the team that is in violation will forfeit the night.

BBDL Covid-19 Rules as it relates to Bars:

- 1. The bars/restaurants are responsible for verifying players proof of vaccination. Players must ensure they have this on them on game night. If this is not provided to the bar, players will not be able to play.
- 2. For tracing purposes, all players must sign in prior to entering the bars/restaurants.
- 3. Bars will not be responsible for serving free food this year.
- 4. The Executive Committee will provide the bars with a list of players who will be playing out of their bars and schedules. Note: Captain's of the bars that I do not have contact information for, will be sent this to provide to their bar.
- 5. The Executive Committee has made the choice that for the welfare of the league, if the bars do not comply with the Government mandates set out, the league will take any necessary steps to temporarily relocate that team to a different bar until the non-compliance bar is following the mandates.
- 6. The bars have every right to ask any BBDL player who is not in compliance, to leave their premises.

Please keep in mind that these rules and regulations are subject to change as they are constantly being updated.
