


Lighting rule addendum January 2019

All steel-tip dart boards will be required to have an LED or fluorescent strip light of no shorter than 24" centered above each board to illuminate the playing surface. If you choose LED then one bulb will be sufficient, if you choose fluorescent then two bulbs will be required. Each light fixture must be 14" to 18" from the front surface of the dart board with full bulb exposure directed towards the board. The height of the light fixture must be 14" to 36" from the top of the dart board. All lights need to have a panel in front of each light as to not allow light to shine towards the player at the toeline. Spot lights of any kind will no longer be allowed for St. Charles Dart League matches due to the shadows created. Lighting corrections must be completed by the Winter session which starts January, 2019



- 14" to 18" from the front of the dartboard playing surface
- 14" to 36" from the top of the dartboard
- light bulb exposure directed to the front of dartboard
- solid panel placed to keep light illumination from player at toeline
